NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in 2013-2016
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the RYA will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising may be displayed in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all Hunter 707s.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and submitting it to the Race Office before 11:00 on Saturday 25 May. Boats may also enter before Thursday 23 May by emailing the attached form to royalforth@btconnect.com
- 3.3 Late entries may be accepted

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The ISAF Sailor Classification Code will apply.

5 FEES

- 5.1 The entry fees for the regatta are £25 per boat.

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 Registration: Saturday 25 May 2013, from 10:00 until 11:00
- 6.2 Briefing: a competitors' briefing will be held at 11:30

6.3 Number of Races: four

6.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 12:55.

Subsequent races will as soon as possible after the completion of the previous race.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available for collection at Registration or may be posted in advance on the RFYC website (www.rfyc.org).

8 RACING AREA

8.1 The racing area will be the RFYC Mid-Firth courses which are within a 2 mile radius of Granton Harbour.

9 COURSE

9.1 The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward type courses.

9.2 Details of the course options will be provided in the Sailing Instructions.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including a tack and a gybe, is required when a boat may have broken a Rule of Part 2 whilst racing.

11 SCORING

11.1 Scoring will be as recommended in RRS Appendix A The Low-Point Scoring System.

11.2 2 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

11.3 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. If four races are completed then one discard is allowed.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk – see Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

A boat is entirely responsible for her own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions or anywhere else, reduces this responsibility.

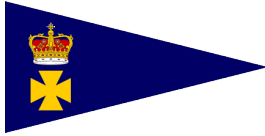
It is for the boat to decide whether she is fit to sail in the conditions in which she will find herself. By going to sea the boat confirms that she is fit for those conditions and her crew is competent to sail and compete in them. Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the boat nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the race and the event, and include the organising authority, the race committee, the race officer, and mark layers.

13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2M.
